

File & Header Formatting

All video masters require a slate and proper header formatting as written out below.

- Start timecode at **00:58:30:00**
- Bars and Tone / Slates:
 - Bars and 1 Khz Tone at -20 dbM from **00:58:30:00** to **00:59:29:23 (60 seconds)**
- Black from **00:59:30:00** to **00:59:39:23 (10 seconds)**
- Slate from **00:59:40:00** to **00:59:49:23 (10 seconds)**
 - Show Title
 - YT Host Channel
 - Episode #
 - Episode Title (if applicable)
 - Master ID
 - Audio Configuration
 - Resolution
 - Aspect Ratio
 - Frame Rate
 - Output Date
 - TRT
- Black from **00:59:50:00** to **00:59:59:23 (10 seconds)**
- Program Start at **01:00:00:00**
- Include One (1) Second of Black after end of Program

Note: *The above timecodes are an example for a 23.98 master.*

Header Format for Multiple Segment Masters

YouTube Masters with multiple segments require slightly different formatting with an additional master slate.

- Start timecode at **00:58:10:00**
- Bars and Tone / Slates:
 - Bars and 1 Khz Tone at -20 dbM from **00:58:10:00** to **00:59:09:23 (60 seconds)**
- Black from **00:59:10:00** to **00:59:19:23 (10 seconds)**
- Master Slate from **00:59:20:00** to **00:59:29:23 (10 seconds)**
 - Show Title
 - YT Host Channel
 - Episode #
 - Episode Title (if applicable)
 - Master ID
 - Timecode In Point - Name of Segment 1 - Segment ID
 - Timecode In Point - Name of Segment 2 - Segment ID
 - Timecode In Point - Name of Segment 3 - Segment ID
 - Audio Configuration
 - Resolution
 - Aspect Ratio
 - Frame Rate
 - Output Date
 - TRT
- Black from **00:59:30:00** to **00:59:39:23 (10 seconds)**
- Segment 1 Slate: **00:59:40:00** to **00:59:49:23 (10 seconds)**
- Black from **00:59:50:00** to **00:59:59:23 (10 seconds)**
- Segment 1 Program Start at **01:00:00:00**
- Include One (1) Second of Black after end of final segment

After each segment ends:

- Round up to the nearest whole minute and then add 1 minute of black
- Add 10 second slate for next segment

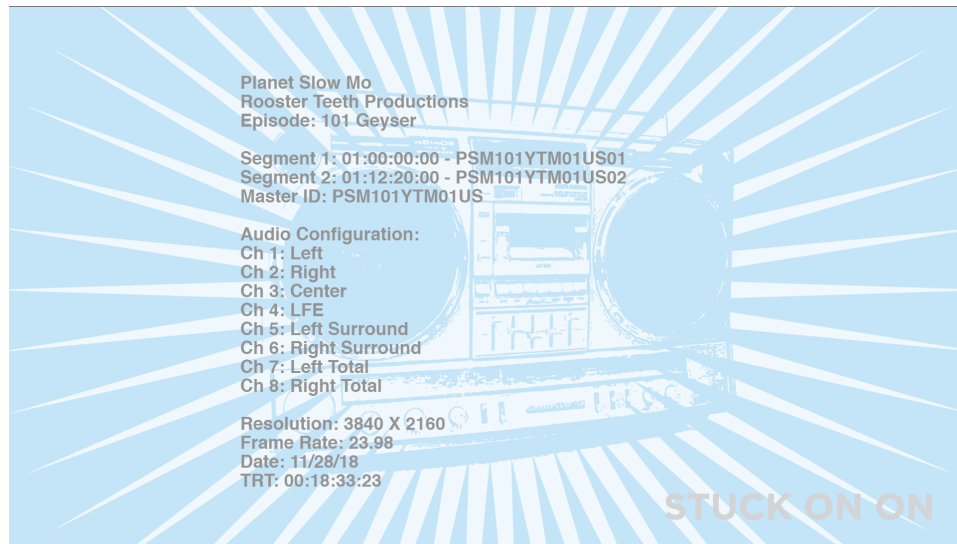
File & Header Formatting

- Add 10 seconds of black
- New segment program starts
- Repeat for all additional segments

A timing sheet must be delivered with each multiple segment master noting where all pieces of content start and end. Please use the [Timing Sheet](#) template.
