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










Morocco maintains a strong tech ecosystem due to high levels of economic development and education








Morocco has one of the most inclusive developer populations; female coders represent nearly half of the 18-24 year old demographic












Informal education channels, like bootcamps, focus coding languages like Java, PHP, and Python



Question: How did you primarily learn to program or code?












Female coders are more heavily represented in full-time roles than in part-time or freelance work







Question: How do you spend your time coding or programming?












Senior developers lead in coding for blockchain, hardware and mobile, while junior coders focus more heavily on desktop and big data platforms









The e-commerce vertical is a critical part of the Moroccan tech ecosystem with a key hub in Casablanca











Venture capital firms play a leading role in funding seed and early stage startups followed closely by accelerators and incubators



Most of the startups are still in early stages of funding, getting much of their funds from incubators, accelerators and venture capital

Outlierz Ventures invests \$50K to \$500K in seed or pre-series A tech-enabled, mostly B2B, companies across Africa





~18% of investors active in Morocco invest solely in the software sector






University programs and other informal channels are critical to developing new coders due to a lack of coding bootcamps

Case Study: 3W Academy

Overview: Started in France, the Casablanca branch opened in 2018. Their main 4-month fee-based training program focuses on full-stack web dev (primarily male students); women make up 50% of the free coding classes, offered via a separate program











Moroccan government & universities are increasingly active in the tech ecosystem, frequently supporting accelerators, incubators, and hubs

Case Study: Emerging Business Factory

Overview: An incubator/hub in Marrakesh which provides some funding, training, and co-working space in exchange for shares. As one of the first incubators in Marrakech, **they focus on technology and media startups**. They currently house 12 startups.

Glossary

Term	Definition
Countries Analyzed	South Africa, Egypt, Morocco, Nigeria, Kenya, Ghana, Rwanda, Ethiopia, Uganda, Tanzania, Ivory Coast
African Startup	A company that meets the following criteria: In growth stage of funding (e.g., seed round, series A - F) Technology-focused Headquartered in Africa or driving the majority of its revenue in Africa
Tech Ecosystem	The network of people, organizations and institutions that enable innovation
Innovator	African startup (see definition above)
Investor	Provides funding in the tech ecosystem (e.g. venture capital, corporate venture capital, angel investors, government funding, private equity)
Educator	Provides technical training or education (e.g. university, bootcamps, online courses, on-the-job training)
Enabler	Provides support in the form of work space, training, education, mentorship or funding (e.g. accelerators, incubators, work hubs)
Professional Developer	An individual that is employed in a job that involves coding and spends 5 or more hours per week coding
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Junior Developer	An individual with less than six years of coding experience
Caniar Davidanar	An individual with air or more than air reason of adding a marianes
Senior Developer	An individual with six or more than six years of coding experience
Formal Education	Universities or secondary schools that provide information communication technology (ICT) curriculum
Informal Education	Bootcamps, online course, self-taught or on-the-job curriculum to teach coding skills
Female Founded Startup	Startup with at least one female founder
