Physically Challenging or Hazardous Activities or Locations

Producer must be diligent in keeping all individuals, locations and equipment safe during production. When production of a program involves physically challenging or potentially hazardous activities or conditions, Producer must take all steps necessary to ensure that each activity is conducted in a responsible and safe manner and that the appropriate insurance certificates are obtained.

Producer must:

- Consult with its Production Counsel regarding whether additional releases should be obtained or medical diligence on participants should be conducted.
- Make appropriate plans for emergency medical assistance, if needed, for any persons involved in production (cast, crew and all on-screen and off-screen participants).
- In a lawful manner, consider collecting medical authorization forms, emergency contact information and other information that may be relevant (e.g., allergies, pre-existing medical conditions).
- Prior to production, discuss production and safety plans with YouTube Security (yto-partner-security@google.com) and YouTube Production.
- Hold a safety meeting at call to instruct personnel of the proper precautions and procedures and include in daily production report on each day on which any stunt or other physically challenging or potentially hazardous activities are performed.
- Post appropriate safety notices as required by law and attach specific information to call sheet.
- Adhere to any local and/or state laws/health regulations related to COVID-19 (and its variants)
- If using any union cast/crew producer, must adhere to each respective union's COVID-19 (and its variants) safety and testing requirements
- Ensure all necessary contingency plans and reasonable safety measures are in place to prevent and mitigate any potential losses relating to COVID-19 (and its variants).
- Please review the <u>Medical & Psychiatric Counsel</u> and the <u>Background Check Policy</u> articles for the requirements on medical, psychiatric, and background check diligence.
- Please refer to the <u>Filming with Animals</u> article in the Production Manual for information regarding filming involving animals.
- Any injury that occurs on set for either cast or crew, no matter how minor, must be
 reported to YouTube Production and YouTube Security by filing an incident report within
 24 hours on the form provided by YouTube and in the daily production report. Please
 follow the Incident Procedure Process in the event of an emergency incident, or medical
 concern.
