File Naming / Master ID

All audio/video materials must be labeled with the correct show abbreviation, episode number, version, and country code. This is the **Master ID**. Bonus Content includes additional identifiers. Specific details and examples are below.

• For Series:

[SHOW-ABBREVIATION] - [EPISODE###] - [VERSION] - [COUNTRYCODE]

Example for Liza on Demand episode 101:

LOD101YTM01US for the YouTube Master [YTM] **LOD101TLM01US** for the Textless Master [TLM]

• For Features, Specials, or Pilots:

• [SHOW-ABBREVIATION] - [###] - [VERSION] - [COUNTRYCODE]

Example for Bodied:

BDED100YTM01US for the YouTube Master [YTM] **BDED100TLM01US** for the Textless Master [TLM]

• For Audio Elements:

- [SHOW-TITLE]_[EP###]_[FRAMERATE]_[LANGUAGE]_[AUDIO CONFIG]_[CHANNEL NAME]
 - Example: ThisIsParisi_101_2398_EN_51_L.wav

• Closed Caption:

- [SHOW-TITLE] [EP###] [FRAMERATE] [LANGUAGE]
 - Example: ThisIsParis_101_2398_EN

Forced Narratives:

- o [SHOW-TITLE] [EP###] [FRAMERATE] [LANGUAGE] ForcedNarrative
 - Example: ThisIsParis_101_2398_EN_ForcedNarrative

• Bonus Content:

- [SHOW-TITLE] [EPISODE#] X [VERSION] [COUNTRYCODE] [SEGMENT#]
- If your show has bonus content, each piece must have its own ID designated by an 'X' and a segment number. The 'X' identifies the content as a Bonus piece.
- Example for Mind Field:

Segment #2 - MF301XYTM01US02

Segment #3 - MF301XYTM01US03

Segment #4 - MF301XYTM01US04

Segment #5 - MF301XYTM01US05

File Naming / Master ID

- The above describes an example of a multi-segment master. If your bonus pieces are delivering as standalone pieces, then the [SEGMENT#] is not required.
- If bonus content is delivered in a multi-segment master, then a <u>timing sheet</u> must be delivered alongside each bonus master noting where all pieces of content start and end.

Important:

• The last four characters of the Master ID, the country code (i.e **01US**) -- do not change. Reach out to your YTO Post contact for your country code. Be sure to work with your YTO Post contacts to ensure your Master IDs are correct.
